

AIRBUS DEFENCE & SPACE UK CASE STUDY

Airbus Defence and Space Ltd partnered with us to hold their Student Presentation Competition at the 2016 National Student Space Conference.

We assisted Airbus Defence and Space in promoting their competition by reaching out to our members and followers for several months in the run up to the conference. As a result of our collaboration in the advertising campaign, Airbus Defence and Space saw a significant increase in the number of applications compared to previous years, receiving numerous outstanding entries from around the country and from universities abroad.

The finalists were given speaking slots at the conference, and UKSEDS invited distinguished professionals and academics from the field to sit with experts from Airbus Defence and Space on the panel of judges.

Following the event, our survey showed a significant increase in the number of students who knew about Airbus' activities, and found that their impression of the company improved significantly as a result of the competition being held at our conference.
